

# **Nordic Combined Events Championship**

Saturday-Sunday 10-11 June 2023

Women and men participants are included in SCEC, a part of the World Combined Events Tour.

The competition is organised by the Swedish Athletics Federation's Combined Events Performance Center and the local club IK Ymer at Ryavallen in Borås.

# Ryavallen (outdoor track) / Ryahallen (indoor track)

Ryavallen and IK Ymer was the host and organiser of European U20 Championships 2019. They have also been the host and organiser of the Swedish Championships 2021.

The stadium is 1,6 km from the hotel with good walking roads.

Walking 15-20 minutes from hotel.

Biking 7 minutes from hotel.

Car 5 minutes from hotel, free parking behind Ryahallen.

**Bibs:** Only one on the front torso, in pole vault you can put it on your back. Team leader get the bibs at the technical meeting.

Entrances: 15 EUR/day or 20 EUR for two days

Kids with IK Ymer Athletics club cloths on get free entrance.

Kids that's going to participate in IK Ymer summer camp also get free entrance.

**Meals at the stadium:** Lunch at competition days 11.30-15.00, Saturday and Sunday at the pub, see map. Dinner Saturday at the stadium pub 17.30-20.30.

**Coaches:** Need accreditation and need to contact Sofia Jäger Stenberg to get it. Coaches can be at the warmup area/indoor track and around the stadium but not on the competition track/field. One exception is for coaches who coaching athletes competing in the inner pole vault field. They can stand in a coaching zone on the gras.

**Changing rooms:** Are available in the athletic indoor hall.

**Toilets:** Under the audience stand and, in the athletics indoor track.

**Warm-up:** Can be done indoors at the indoor track or outside the stadium.

Implement check: If you have your own throwing equipment, you need to take them to the implement check for control at least one hour before your competition starts on Saturday (these means both shot, javelin and discus). We don't take any equipment for control on Sunday. The equipment takes back to the implement check room after the competition. To get your equipment back, you go to the implement check when the combined events is finished.

### Call-room and entrance to the arena

**Calling time:** Only the first event each day. 20 minutes before running 30 minutes before long jump.

Entrance to the arena:

15 minutes before start of running event 25 minutes before start of long jump.

### **Throwing events**

You are going to get two warmups throws in the throwing events.

For safety reasons if they are any left throwers in discus, we are going to use the wing for both left and right throwers. If there aren't any left throwers the wings are going to be opened.

**Shoes:** Remember the shoe rule that's applying on all events in the combined events. It's your responsibility as an athlete to follow <u>these rules</u>.

**Doping control:** It will be some doping controls on the competition. Remember to take your ID with you to the stadium.

**Kiosk:** It's going to be a kiosk open at the stadium for audience and competitors if you want something more to eat then what you get at the "pub area". The kiosk is located in Ryahallen.
